The Third Man. A film noir classic or a cricket fielding position? In this case neither as I'm referring to 'The Cambridge Five' which was the spy ring that included Donald Maclean among Kim Philby, Guy Burgess, Anthony Blunt and John Cairncross. While fascism was on the march between the World Wars all five became convinced that Marxism-Leninism, as evident in Soviet Russia was, the way forward. Maclean had been educated at Gresham's School and the current Head of History there. Simon Kinder, is an authority on such twentieth century matters. A recent biography of Maclean is symptomatic of revived interest in the Cold War as Russia shows signs of going rogue and the teaching of history seems to be more sympathetic to Marxism. Simon's talk is titled 'A Perfect Partnership - an unlikely tale of Norfolk Espionage and Treachery' - 7.30 on Tuesday at The Feathers.
